Emergency Service charge for the gates is now \$600/hr. with a 4-hour minimum charge. At that rate, John Butchko, Don Smoot and I (Rich) have saved LTEA about \$26,000 in FY20. Held a fish fry for the Fishing Contest participants; 22 people attended. Good food, lots of prizes, great fellowship, and the big winners were Tanner Cox and Dustin Kinney. Discussed plans for next year; Toby Cox suggested we keep trying to weed out the smaller bass and have a contest during spawning season.
