 - iii. damaged culverts: culvert on E Autumn; flooding two PO yards; two other culverts that need to be fixed
 - iv. tree cutting; Neff helped last year along w/ other POs; 14 trees need removal, another 20 trees are dead and will need to be cut down asap; will contact POs to let POs know
 - v. budget for upcoming year: wil be short; hope to save money by doing work ourselves; side roads held up well with oil-and-chip because snow plow stayed higher
 - vi. PO: question regarding snow removal and it is determined
 - 1. Davis: 2" snow alerts removal; if things are bad call him; ice is salted

 - Grass Carp were purchased in October 2023 and placed in all LTEA waters in an attempt to alleviate the over growing vegetation. At this point the results are unclear however it is being monitored
 - ii. Last week, 1500 fish were distributed into the chain of lakes (750 Black Crappie, 750 Blue Gill). Paid receipts have or will be submitted to the treasure.

- iii. goose egg debacle: Late start and the process is ongoing. We have noticed some nests have hatched because they could not be located in time. A complete total of nests addressed and a total egg count will be submitted the Illinois Department of Natural Resources in accordance with State Law.
