Comcast installation going well, 8.5 miles of boring; 7 problems w/ cutting AT&T lines; PO water line was hit but fixed that day; mailbox damaged but is fixed; crews coming in behind w/ grass seed

- PO question regarding why aren't lines installed above ground in some locations

 Davis: some AT&T lines not buried deep enough

- a. Comcast update: Svymbersky (Comcast)
 - i. difficult installation if lines aren't marked
 - ii. 36 homes over 250 ft from box; installation in easement, some might be on property if folks want connection now
 - iii. crooked utility boxes will be straightened
 - iv. as they get ready to deploy services, they want to be respectful about getting folks ready to be signed up; will coordinate with Board about date/time to talk to POs about service
 - 1. Kinney coordinating collection event for June 23, Comcast could set up a table there
 - v. Svymbersky leaves letter and list of addresses for 25 people who are too far back from road, Davis will review list and coordinate letters
 - vi. Svymbersky will provide material to add on to bulletin boards regarding services

 - i. spoke to gentleman who does certificates, currently out of town but will do inspection

 - i. Per Sean Deneau: "When this came up awhile back, I did check with the insurance company. They have no issues with this either way. This is an LTEA discussion, not an insurance issue."

 - c. 3. Bridge weight limit is 16,000 pounds, or 8 tons, at all times.i. NOTE: may change depending on bridge inspection
 - d. 4. Road weight limit is 5 tons from December 1st to April 1st or after, depending on the road conditions and/or weather as determined by the Roads Committee Chairman.
 - e. 5. Road weight limit is 25 tons from April 1st or after, depending on conditions, until December 1st.
 - f. 6. Load limit variance request shall be submitted in writing to the LTEA Board, or in the event of an emergency, to the Road Committee Chairman.
