- 1. Call to Order: President
 - a. time: 6:06pm
- 2. Pledge of Allegiance
- 3. Roll Call: Secretary
 - a. Present: Blundy, Kinney, Butson, Buck, Cole, Davis, Palmer
 - b. Absent, Excused: Huddleston, Bohlen, Neff
 - c. Special guests: Art Svymbersk & Adam March
- 4. Opening Remarks: President
 - a. Main goal is to obtain an agreement for Comcast services to be installed within LTEA.
- 5. Discussion regarding potential installation of Comcast cable facilities
 - a. PRESENTATION LOCATED HERE: https://lteail.com/documents.html
 - b. State of IL has a Connect Illinois project to provide broadband to underserved areas; LTEA was identified as areas that fits grant
 - c. 374 lots; would like to start February 19; projected finish end of June 2024
 - d. Comcast would like to know about gaining access to properties and any special building permit/drainage/utility permit specifically required by LTEA.
 - i. Will follow commercial power easement for utilities.
 - e. Blundy: concerns
 - i. repair timeline needs clarified
 - ii. 48" utility depth required by Vermilion Co, contract states 36" depth
 - 1. Comcast: Below 48" is below freeze line so it can affect water/sewer which is why they typically do 36"; will provide clarification.
 - f. Some lots have 8 ft easement, most have 10 ft; big trucks might cause asphalt damage
 - i. Comcast will be responsible to fix any damage
 - g. Comcast has contract/agreements already w/ Oakwood, Danville, other towns and municipalities
 - i. Buck: wants specific contract for LTEA
 - 1. Does company have right of way?
 - a. permission from POs would be required if services are needed more off main line
 - b. contractor will follow commercial power; does not guarantee an easement but usually does; plan currently follows roadmap and they don't expect to come on private property unless PO wants service

- 2. Buck concern: if something did arise for access in terms of major utilities, would PO be notified?
 - a. contractor hasn't completed walkout; any possible access to private properties would be identified
- h. points of contact for any PO that might have concern
 - i. typically one member of their team; one board member of an HOA is also a point of contact who would contact contractor
- i. restoration expectation
 - i. grass mat and seed
 - ii. it is a time of year where grass isn't growing so they will restore again later in year if necessary
 - iii. restoration crews should immediately follow installation; 7-10 business days; sometimes that can be longer depending on location
- j. Buck: would like to see a timeline of when all work would be completed
 - i. would work quickly to get any larger damage done to any of the public infrastructure
 - ii. Davis: if there is damage to some items (like culverts), damage might not be seen until later
 - 1. if it is documented that Comcast's conduits are at that location, they would pay the invoice for correction or restore themselves as contractor is also drainage specialists.
 - 2. Davis: timeline for investigations into such issues?
 - a. all dependent on investigation
- k. Palmer: does the contract/agreement provided to other communities and municipalities mirror the same?
 - i. haven't reached agreement yet but the language would be similar
 - ii. Blundy: because we maintain our own roads, separate contract would be preferred specific for LTEA
- I. Blundy: service to houses included?
 - i. there would likely be some sort of go-to market deal, doesn't know if it would be free
- m. Buck: when will service be available?
 - i. beginning of June for everyone; some people might be sooner
- n. Palmer: any homes that would not have service
 - i. contractor not aware
- o. Davis: will it piggyback with AT&T?
 - i. no all on their own
- a. Blundy: what documents does LTEA need from contractor to move forward?
 - i. only want agreement w/ Comcast
 - ii. certificate of insurance update
- b. Davis: requests Special Meeting to review and discuss revised documents when provided
